



Authorisation requirements

A residence permit may be granted to a retired and/or pensioner immigrant as long as they can prove a monthly transfer to Brazil of an amount equal to or greater than USD 2,000.00 (US dollars).



Apply for a visa from anywhere in the world

To apply for a visa, all you need to do is go to a Brazilian Consular Office and submit the documents corresponding to the visa you want, in accordance with the Normative Resolution No. 40/2019.



Are you in Brazil on a trip and would like to apply for a residence permit? Find out how

If the immigrant is travelling through Brazil, they can apply for a residence permit through the Immigration Management and Control System website MigranteWeb, based on the Normative Resolution No. 40/2019, which can be accessed via Immigration Portal.



Period of residence in Brazil

The immigrant can reside in the country for an initial period of 2 (two) years, which may be renewed indefinitely.
